Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.128 dated 24.06.2021, under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 325 and 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that there is a delay of six days in lodging the FIR and the petitioners have been attributed simple injuries. Petitioner No.1 is 22 years of age while petitioner No.2 is 20 years of age and they do not have any criminal antecedents.

This Court, by the order dated 31.08.2021, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sukhdeep Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 31.08.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
