The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this writ petition, the petitioner prays for permission to correct his name in Annexure P-2.

It has been asserted that the petitioner while filing the application (Annexure P-1), disclosed his correct particulars i.e.

Applicant name: Ankush

Father's name: Joginder Singh

Mother's name: Sudesh

However, when he filed Annexure P-2, due to a printing error the applicant's name got mentioned as “Sudesh” which is, in fact, the name of the petitioner's mother.

The petitioner applied for correction which has not been decided.

Mr. Samarth Sagar, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, was requested to take instructions.

Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, after taking instructions, has stated that the respondent-Commission has taken a decision to permit the petitioner to correct the name in the peculiar facts of the case.

He, however, submits that such a decision should not be treated as precedent.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

Needless to observe that such permission shall not be treated as precedent.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
