The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned chargesheet dated 08.11.2019 (Annexure P2) under Rule 7 of Haryana Civil Services Rules 2016 whereby the petitioner has been ordered to be issued provisional pension and the entire gratuity amount of the petitioner has been withheld.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents are directed to take the final decision on the impugned chargesheet dated 08.11.2019 (Annexure P-2), within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, D.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to take the final decision on impugned chargesheet 08.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioner is found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioner within a further period of three months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
