On 27.08.2021, the following order was passed:-

*“The hearing of the case was held through video
conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the
Courts.*

*This petition has been filed by the wife seeking the
transfer of the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu
Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.HMA/149/2021, titled
as 'Kulip Singh vs. Kulwinder Kaur' pending in the
Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Jalandhar to
the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.*

*The petitioner claims that she got married to the
respondent on 23.10.2017. She claims that at present,
she alongwith her minor child is residing at Ludhiana
and cannot properly defend the petition at Jalandhar as
the distance between the two places is 73 kms.*

*Learned counsel representing the petitioner
contends that the respondent-husband is already facing
trial in a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C at Ludhiana.*

*The liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve the
respondent through his counsel Sh. Rakesh Dhir, District
Court, Jalandhar.*

The factual aspects as noticed in the order dated 27.08.2021, are not disputed.

Hence, the application is allowed.

The petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.HMA/149/2021, titled as 'Kulip Singh vs. Kulwinder Kaur' pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Jalandhar, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 11.10.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
