This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for seeking permission for correction/modification of the name of petitioner No.3 in the memo of parties.

The application is allowed as prayed for and the amended memo of parties is taken on record.

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This is a criminal revision petition filed to challenge the order dated 16.07.2021 passed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, titled as "*State Vs. Satnam Singh and others*", whereby the application under Section 227 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioners for discharging them, has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners may kindly be permitted to withdraw the revision petition with

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liberty to take up all the points during the course of trial. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that as far as petitioner Nos.1 and 2 are concerned, they both are ladies and since the other family members are already facing trial, thus, it has been prayed that the personal appearance of said petitioner Nos.1 and 2 may kindly be exempted.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to take up all the points during the course of trial.

Since petitioner Nos.1 and 2 are ladies and their relatives are also facing trial, thus, in the interest of justice, the personal appearance of petitioner Nos.1 and 2 namely, Balwinder Kaur and Manjinder Kaur, respectively, is exempted subject to the following conditions:-

- i) Petitioner Nos.1 and 2 shall be represented through their counsel;*
- ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;*
- iii) shall not dispute their identity as accused;*
- iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in their absence but in the presence of their counsel;*
- v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court;*
- vii) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.*
