Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to recalculate and sanction the family pension of the petitioner as per SBI Norms and release the same along with difference of amount from 03.04.2017 up to date with overdue interest @ 18% per annum to the petitioner from the date of accrual till actual payment.

Upon hearing learned counsel and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 26.03.2021 (Annexure P-7) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
