Mr. Karanjeet Singh Brar, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondent No.4 in this case and has submitted his Power of Attorney in the Court and the same is taken on the record.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Satpal Singh, PS City-1, Abohar, District Fazilka, apprises the Court that the alleged detainee named Farah Noor has made a statement before the Police authorities to the effect that she has already attained the age of majority and has married respondent No.4-Aakash and is happily residing with him and that she has not been illegally detained by respondent No.4 and rather, she as well as respondent No.4 had also moved a petition before this Court for seeking protection of their life and liberty.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 has placed the copy of

the order dated 16.08.2021 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench in CRWP No.7743 of 2021 titled as *Farha Noor and another v. State of Punjab and others* on the record whereby a direction has been given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition in view of the above-discussed submission of learned State counsel as well as the contents of the order dated 16.08.2021.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.4 have no objection for the same.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn.
