1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.118 dated 06.11.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC (Sections 467, 468, 471 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Kotwali Nabha, District Patiala.

2. By an order dated 28.09.2020, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State on instructions from ASI Jai Parkash submits that the petitioner has joined investigation.
