Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 128 dated 17.07.2021, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Jathlana, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is of 70 years of age. The petitioner had borrowed an amount of Rs. 3 lakh from one Sushil Kumar for the treatment of his wife and in lieu thereof given a security cheque to him and not to the complainant. But the complainant in connivance with Sushil Kumar misused the said cheque and falsely implicated the petitioner in this case. As a matter of fact, the petitioner has

nothing to do with the appointment letters issued to the children of the complainant. As per the complainant, two appointment letters were issued to his son and daughter under the stamp of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, whereupon, when they approached the said University, Kurukshetra, came to know that these letters had not been issued by the University and the stamp affixed on the said appointment letters was also fake.

Indisputably, the cheque had been issued by the petitioner. The said cheque was dishonoured, which clearly shows an active participation of the petitioner in the crime. Moreover, it is an act of defrauding the ordinary citizens by alluring them to give Government jobs.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
