The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail as by virtue of order dated 12.08.2021 (Annexure P-4), the bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner were cancelled and forfeited and he has been summoned by way of warrant of arrest for 02.09.2021

Anticipatory bail petition against an order issuing warrant of arrest is not maintainable has been held by this Court in ***Balwant Singh @***

Banta Versus State of Punjab 2019 (2) Law Herald 1786. However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on 02.09.2021 and joins the proceedings, files a petition for grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall make an endeavour and decide the same within a period of one week from the date of its filing.
