By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR No.105, dated 02.03.2020, having been registered at Police Station City, Barnala, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 392 of the IPC.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh, submits that pursuant to the order dated 16.10.2020, the petitioner has joined investigation and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioner's custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 7 days' notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he/she would be always at liberty to avail of his/her remedy as per law.
