The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for extension of parole for a further period of eight weeks on account of pregnancy of the wife of the petitioner.

Upon instructions, from SI, Sahil Choudhry, State counsel submits that the wife of the petitioner had delivered a child on 24.08.2021 and was discharged from the hospital on 27.08.2021.

In view of this development, there is no ground for grant of extension of the period of parole.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
