The prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. For quashing of order Annexure P/3 dated 07.12.2019, passed by learned Magistrate, 1st Class, District Jalandhar, wherein the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed person in case FIR No.08 dated 23.01.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the FIR, there were three accused i.e. the petitioner and his parents. He submits that on the conclusion of the investigation his father was declared innocent, whereas, challan was presented qua him and his mother. He submits that thereafter, the compromise was arrived at between his mother and the complainant-wife. On the basis of the compromise arrived at, the FIR qua the mother-Inderpal Kaur of the petitioner was quashed by this Court vide order dated 12.03.2020, which has been placed on record as

Annexure P-6. He further submits that the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person on 07.12.2019, which is unsustainable in the eyes of law. He also submits that the petitioner is ready to settle the dispute amicably with his wife and abide by all the terms and conditions.

In the peculiar facts and circumstances, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to appear before the Court concerned within 10 days from today. If he appears before the Court concerned within a period afore-mentioned and files an appropriate application, the Court concerned would deal with the same in accordance with law.

The petitioner would have a protection from arrest for 7 days from the date of the filing of such application.

Disposed of.
