Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that all the retiral benefits have already been released. He submits that this writ petition is restricted to claiming interest on the delayed payment. He further contends that there is an inordinate delay in the release of the amount.

From the facts it has been noticed that the petitioner proceeded on extra-ordinary leave without pay from 09.05.2009 to 08.05.2012 and thereafter did not join back the office and instead sought premature retirement. Still further, the petitioner in-between remained on deputation with Army Institute of Law, Mohali and Khalsa College, Amritsar. While rejecting the claim for grant of interest, the competent authority has noticed that the contribution to be paid by the aforesaid institutes was not received in time.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petitioner is relegated to the alternative remedy of Civil Court. This Court is not inclined to

entertain the writ petition in the facts of the case.
