1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-3) dated 16.09.2019 in CWP No.19337 of 2019.
3. Learned counsel contends that vide order, Annexure P/3 dated 16.09.2021, CWP No.19337 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondents to give benefit to the petitioners in terms of Annexure R/1. Learned counsel states that pursuant to the order of this Court as referred to above, the respondents have passed order dated 07.09.2021 declining relief to the petitioners in terms of Annexure R/1 referred to in CWP No.19337 of 2019 on ground of the petitioners not being covered by the same. Learned counsel states that in the circumstances he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition as the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the same but

with liberty to challenge order dated 07.09.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondents.

5. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such by granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 07.09.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
