The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ directing the respondents to release the entire death cum retirement benefits qua leave encashment, gratuity, provident fund etc., for which, legal notice dated 30.04.2021 (Annexure P-5) has also been submitted before the respondent authorities.

Heard.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioners' side

the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider legal notice dated 30.04.2021 (Annexure P-5) as representation of petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay as per law.
