This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.44 dated 04.04.2020, under Sections 323, 34, 283, 188, 269 & 270 of the IPC (offence punishable under Section 452 of the IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda.

[2]. Notice of motion.

[3]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Sewak, Additional Advocate General, Punjab to accept notice on behalf of the respondent/State. Let a copy of the Paper-book be supplied to him.

[4]. Ld. State Counsel, on instructions from A.S.I. Jagtar Singh, submits that the petitioner is already co-operative in investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

[5]. In view of such submission and considering that all the offences made out in the FIR have already been drawn up pertaining to the summons in triable/bailable cases, the petitioner's prayer for anticipatory

bail is allowed and he may, therefore, be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, he shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
