The present petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of the petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 bearing HMA No.1097 of 2020 titled as "*Ravinder Kumar Vs. Pushpa Kumari*" for the dissolution of marriage, pending before the District Court, Gurugram to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that presently the petitioner is staying with her parents in District Jhajjar and that she has to travel a distance of 60 kms in order to attend the proceedings at District Court, Gurugram. It is further the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that three cases are already pending before the District Courts, Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the respondent has contended that the distance is hardly 60 kms and it is not difficult for the petitioner to travel to District Court, Gurugram and in any case she is not required to be present there on each and every date.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above and keeping in mind the fact that the petitioner has to travel 60 kms to District Court, Gurugram and that three cases filed by the wife are already pending at Jhajjar, I deem it appropriate to allow the present petition and to transfer the petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 bearing HMA No.1097 of 2020 titled as "*Ravinder Kumar Vs. Pushpa Kumari*" for the dissolution of marriage, pending before the District Court, Gurugram to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Jhajjar.

The records of the case shall be sent by the concerned Court to the Court of learned District Judge, Jhajjar and the parties shall appear there on 02.12.2021 at 10.00 a.m.

The present petition is disposed off in the above terms.
