This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in this writ petition is for taking action against illegal plying of the commercial public vehicles without obtaining/ holding a permit/ permission.

It is submitted that petitioner had moved complaint/representation to the authorities regarding illegal plying of public transport vehicles without obtaining/holding a permit or permission between Hodal (Haryana) to Badarpur Border (Delhi), as well as the petitioner not being permitted to operate at the Palwal bus stand, despite having the requisite permit/ permission.

It is averred that the petitioner was forced to sign on compromise agreements, which were not signed by the other party.

Grievance of petitioner was not addressed and in this respect another

representation was addressed by the petitioner to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Palwa, Annexure P-10, wherein specific mention of an incident which took place on 22.07.2021 has been made, besides threats held out to the authorized representative of the petitioner. However no action whatsoever has been taken by the respondent-authorities.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sharan Sethi, Addl.AG., Haryana, at the asking of the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Advance copy of the writ petition already stands supplied.

Keeping in view the nature of the order, which is being passed, there is no necessity of reply on behalf of the respondents.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, but without any expression of opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2-Superintendent of Police, Palwal, to look into the matter and take necessary action, if any, as may be required within four weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order. Furthermore the concerned Regional Transport Officer(s) to also look into the averments regarding illegal plying of public transport vehicles & take necessary action as may be/ if any required.
