The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.141, dated 02.09.2020, registered under Sections 420, 406, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, (Section 370 IPC added later on) and Section 10 of the Immigration Act (Section 24 of the Immigration Act, added later on), at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. The Petitioner has remained in detention for more almost two months since 9th July, 2021. In the meantime, investigation against him has already been completed and Challan submitted.

3. All the other co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this Court, earlier.

4. Trial in the case is yet to commence.

5. In the circumstances and without commenting upon the other merits of the case, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the Petitioner for an indefinite period, at this stage, is not called for. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
