The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Though the instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a direction to transfer the investigation in FIR No.92 dated 14.05.2021, registered for offences under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Phase 1, S.A.S. Nagar (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner has restricted the prayer to a directive to the official respondents to look into the representation dated 12.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner, who is the wife of accused.

Request made by counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali – respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 12.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law in case any substance is found in the same.

A copy of this order as well as representation dated 12.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) be communicated to respondent No.3 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
