The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.23 dated 11.07.2020 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case for motivated

considerations. He is innocent and has never indulged in such like illegal activities.

Learned State counsel submits that recovery of 8 *tola* of gold is yet to be effected in the case. Moreover, after getting interim protection from this Court, the petitioner is embarrassing the complainant while sitting on *dharna* at public places.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner and the fact that the allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
