The petitioner has prayed for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.507 dated 20.11.2019 registered under Sections 407, 408, 420, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala.

On 31.08.2021, the following order was passed:-

“Submits inter alia that the name of the petitioner has come only through the disclosure statement of the Driver, namely, Naib Singh of the concerned vehicle and that the petitioner is unconnected in any manner with the alleged offence, and that he is actually an Agriculturist by profession.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Anmol Malik, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, to accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Let a copy of the Paper-book be supplied to him.

4. Adjourned to 18.11.2021.

5. Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting/Investigating Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-”

- I. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;
- II. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer and;
- III. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Om Parkash has stated that pursuant to the order dated 31.08.2021, the petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the interim order dated 31.08.2021 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

This petition stands disposed of.
