ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

Vide this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. the petitioner prays for regular bail in FIR No. 17 dated 5.2.2020, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Rori, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that recovery of 78 strips, each containing 10 tablets (total 780 tablets having total weight of 642.72 grams) of Tramadol Hydrochloride tablets was caused from the person of the petitioner on 5.2.2020. He submits that the petitioner is 62 years of age. In reference to Annexure P-1 and P-2, he submits that the petitioner is hearing impaired, for he suffers from 90% permanent disability. Since the petitioner was arrested on 5.2.2020, he has been in custody for over one and a half years.

The factual position as set out above is not disputed by the learned State counsel. Upon being pointedly asked, he submits that the petitioner has no antecedents as he is not involved in any similar matter.

In the wake of the above, this court is of the considered opinion that the petitioner is entitled to the concession of bail.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/ Duty Magistrate, Sirsa
