The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* quashing and setting aside the orders/communications (Annexure P-1 and Annexure P-2) with further prayer to direct the respondents to pay the arrears of interim relief for the period from 01.01.2016 to 28.12.2019 and further to pay travelling allowance/daily allowance for the additional duties performed, for which, representation

23.08.2018 has also been submitted before the respondent-authorities.

At the asking of the Court Ms. Simran Grewal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let copy of the paper book be supplied to her.

Upon hearing the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider representation dated 23.08.2018 (Annexure P-5) of petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
