Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for preponement of the main petition, which is otherwise fixed for hearing on 13.10.2021.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed and the hearing of the petition is preponed and the same is taken on board today itself.

CRM-M-35618-2021

This is a petition that has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.111, dated 30.06.2021, registered under Sections 363 and 366-A of IPC at Police Station Doraha, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that in the aforesaid FIR, the matter has been compromised between the parties vide compromise deed dated 17.08.2021 and a petition i.e. CRM-M-34666-2021 seeking quashing of FIR has already been filed. Petitioner is in custody since 03.07.2021.

Learned State counsel, on the other hand, would oppose the grant of bail to the petitioner referring to seriousness of the allegations.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the fact that the matter has been settled between the parties, no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind the bars any longer. Accordingly, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of personal bond in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

However, any observation made herein shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on merits of the case.
