Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.36 dated 04.06.2021, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of version and cross version in which both the parties received injuries. There is a delay of four days in registering the FIR. The petitioner has been attributed a 'gandasi' blow with reverse side on the elbow of the injured. He is not involved in any other criminal case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Rajpal Singh, contends that the injuries which is attributed to the petitioner resulted in fracture of the elbow of the injured Kabal Singh. He also contends that no injuries were received by the petitioner in the incident.

Heard.

In view of the serious allegations against the petitioner of having fractured the elbow of the injured with a 'gandasi', I do not deem it appropriate to grant him concession of anticipatory bail.

The petition stands dismissed.
