Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to pay interest @ 12% per annum on the delayed payment of pension and other retiral benefits.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.
