The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0145 dated 04.05.2019 under Section 22 (C) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that 58,600 intoxicant tablets of Tramadol were recovered from the house of co-accused Kuldeep alias Deepu. He also contends that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the disclosure statement of co-accused Kuldeep alias Deepu. There is no *prima facie* evidence which would connect the petitioner with the alleged commission of offence. He is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ellenabad, District Sirsa wherein it is stated that the petitioner was in regular touch with co-accused, Kuldeep and had made repeated phone calls. The call details have been set out in para 4 of the reply.

It is also stated that the petitioner is running a medical pharmacy and had supplied intoxicant tablets to the co-accused.

Heard through video conferencing.

It is, thus, manifest that 58,600 tablets of Taramadol had been recovered from the house of co-accused. The total weight is approximately 31.386 kgs. The petitioner was in touch with co-accused on his mobile and had made several calls to him prior to the recovery. Therefore, I do not find it an appropriate case to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner and the petition stands dismissed.

However, nothing whatsoever, which has been observed hereinabove, shall have any bearing on the merits of the case.
