The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the revised pension/family pension in the pay scale of Rs.15600-39100 + 5400 grade pay + Sectt. Pay of Rs.2000/- effect from 01.12.2011 and release the consequential financial benefits with interest @ 8% from the due date till actual date of payment, for which, representation dated 20.05.2020 (Annexure

P-18) has also been submitted before the respondent authorities.

At the asking of the Court Ms. Simran Grewal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. Let copy of the paper book be supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider representation dated 20.05.2020 (Annexure P-18) of petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
