1. This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 120, dated 12th June, 2021, under Section 21/61/ 29 (added later on) NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Roopnagar, District Roopnagar.

2. The police party during routine checking on 12th June, 2021 apprehended Mohinder Pal Singh, recovery of 3120 capsules of Spasmo Proxyvon Plus and 1800 tablets of alprazolam was made and in his disclosure statement he named the petitioner(Anshul Jain) as supplier of seized contraband.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was named in disclosure statement, no recovery was made from him, investigation is complete and he is not involved in any other case.

4. Learned State counsel on instructions opposes the prayer for grant of regular bail, however, he fairly submits that challan stand presented, petitioner was named in the disclosure statement and no recovery was made from him.

5. The name of the petitioner surfaced in the disclosure statement. He is in custody since 15th June, 2021, no recovery was made from him, he has no criminal antecedents and conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, the petitioner is granted bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
6. The petition is allowed.
7. It is clarified that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
