Petitioner Surjit Singh in this petition has invoked the civil writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ or direction by way of certiorari seeking quashing of orders (Annexure P5, P6, P15, P16 and P17).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the records.

The primary grouse of the petitioner is that while working as a Lower Division Clerk, he was departmentally dealt with and punishments were imposed which he has challenged by way of statutory appeals and which are still pending since a long time and the respondents are not adjudicating upon them.

Be that as it may, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to expedite disposal of the statutory appeals detailed above and to decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of two month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
