This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of certiorari quashing the notice dated 21.11.2020 (Annexure P-44) whereby the petitioner has been illegally taken to have voluntarily resigned from the service by the Bank w.e.f. 23.09.2020, without granting leave to the petitioner, in an absolute illegal, arbitrary manner without transferring the petitioner or the accused officer, without holding the enquiry by the Internal Complaints Committee, all in violation of the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013. It is further prayed that the respondents be directed to decide the statutory appeal dated 12.04.2021 (Annexure P-47) filed by the petitioner; within a time bound frame.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents take a decision on the statutory appeal dated 12.04.2021 (Annexure P-47) filed by the petitioner, within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mrs. Madhu Dayal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-Bank. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the statutory appeal filed by the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the statutory appeal dated 12.04.2021 (Annexure P-47) filed by the petitioner; within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
