The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* to direct the respondents to release the benefits of first ACP with due date i.e. - 1.10.2009 alongwith interest @ 18% per annum alongwith other certain prayer.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 25.06.2021 (Annexure P-11), within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl.AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice issued by the petitioner dated 25.06.2021 (Annexure P-11) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioner is found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioner within a further period of three months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
