The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.219 dated 17.10.2020, under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Rajound, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the insurance claims were fraudulently raised but there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. There is no material against the petitioner and he has neither signed any document for disbursement of the insurance nor any amount has been deposited in his bank accounts.

Learned State counsel, however, while pointing out the reply filed by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, STF (H), Unit Rohtak, states that the petitioner along with co-accused was actively involved in raising fraudulent insurance claims. There are several transactions when the money had been deposited in the account of the petitioner and the details thereof have been mentioned therein.

In view of the serious allegations against the petitioner being involved in raising false insurance claims, I do not deem it appropriate to grant him the concession of anticipatory bail.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
