Petitioners herein, *inter alia*, seek issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to revise their emoluments by taking into consideration the revised pay scale, as claimed by them are admissible under Sixth/Seventh Pay Commission.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that qua their aforesaid grievance, petitioners submitted many representations, but to no avail. Hence, the instant petition.

3. Perusal of the record appended with the writ petition reflects that various representations have been submitted by the petitioners from time to time.

4. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and submits that in order to obviate any confusion on earlier representations, the instant writ petition can be treated as fresh representation and appropriate administrative order shall be passed, in accordance with law, in due course.

5. Learned Senior counsel submits that in fact, favourable decision has already been taken as is borne out from the recommendation/proceedings contained at Annexure P-6 but the same has not been implemented by the respondents.

Be that as it may, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioners and also by keeping in view the contentions raised in the present petition by treating the same as fresh representation and take a decision, in accordance with law. Let the needful be done as expeditiously as possible but not later than 6 months from today. In case, any favourable order is passed, then benefit thereof be accorded to the petitioners within a period of two months thereafter.
