Prayer in the instant application is for preponement of main petition, which is fixed for 02.05.2022, on the ground that in compliance of the order dated 03.03.2021 passed by this Court, the parties have got their statements recorded before learned trial Court and report dated 31.03.2021 to the said effect has also been received at Flag 'B'.

In view of the above, the application is allowed. Accordingly, the main petition is preponed and taken on board today itself.

Main case

In pursuance of the orders dated 03.03.2021 passed by this Court, a report has been received from learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Bahadurgarh at Flag 'B' stating therein that the compromise arrived at between the parties is without any pressure or coercion from any one and the same is genuine.

Learned State counsel and learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2-complainant admit the factum of compromise and submit that they have no objection to the quashing of the FIR.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record.

After considering the nature of offences allegedly committed and the fact that both the parties have amicably settled their dispute, continuance of criminal prosecution would be an exercise in futility, as the chances of ultimate conviction are bleak.

Consequently, keeping in view the fact that the dispute has been amicably settled between the parties and in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466, this petition is allowed and FIR No.355 dated 21.09.2019, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 364, 379-B, 506 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua the petitioners.
