This order shall dispose off the aforesaid two petitions i.e. CRM-M-30496-2020 filed on behalf of Rahul & others and CRM-M-30616-2020 filed on behalf of Sandeep Kumar & another seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.255 dated 04.09.2020 at Police Station Civil Lines, Kaithal, under Sections 323, 148, 149, 379-B, 427, 452 & 506 IPC.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the matter has been amicably resolved amongst the parties and that the accused shall pay a lump sum amount of Rs.2,25,000/- to the complainant as full & final settlement.
3. Mr. G.S.Sandhu, Advocate, representing the complainant has gracefully submitted that his client shall accept the aforesaid offer and shall make a statement in favour of the accused for getting the FIR quashed on the basis of compromise. He has further stated that he has no objection in case the petitioners are granted anticipatory bail keeping in view the fact that the matter has been amicably resolved.
4. In view of the aforesaid position, both the petitions are accepted and the interim directions dated 30.09.2020 in CRM-30496-2020 and 05.10.2020 in CRM-M-30616-2020 are hereby confirmed subject to the condition that the petitioners duly honour the compromise, which is stated to have been effected amongst the parties.
