The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the wages of the petitioner from 01.07.2013 to 10.08.2015, for which period, even after retirement on 30.06.2013, the petitioner was made to discharge the duties of the post of Inspector Grade I for the preservation of wheat of respondent-Corporation with interest @ 21% per annum, for which, legal notice dated 12.07.2021 (Annexure P-16) has also

been served upon the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider legal notice dated 12.07.2021 (Annexure P-16) as representation of petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
