MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to conduct fair, impartial and expeditious investigation on the complaints moved by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was put under threat and was forced to marry accused/respondent No.5-Jashanpreet Singh and now she has come out of his clutches and gave a representation/complaint dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure p-2), however, no FIR has been registered upon it so far. He submits that for the time being, petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the official respondents to consider the

representation and take appropriate action.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that the petitioner along with Jashanpreet had filed a petition bearing No. CRWP-3265-2021 seeking protection of their life and liberty against relatives of petitioner No.1 and even request made by her father to meet or talk with the petitioner was also declined. He submits that the said petition was also signed by the petitioner because of threat to her life by accused/respondent No.5- Jashanpreet Singh.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the above background, this Court finds that the petitioner is taking conflicting stands and the same do not appeal to prudence. There is no explanation as to how alleged threat to her life vanished and further the representation is also in the shape of legal notice, therefore, no ground is made out for exercise of inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
