Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.0108 dated 26.07.2020, under Section 420 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been falsely involved in the above noted FIR. It has been alleged that the petitioner owed money to send the complainant-Gurpreet Singh, abroad. The counsel for the petitioner states that the blank cheque, in question, was for the kitty committee, and the complainant have wrongly presented the blank cheque of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel assisted by Mr. M.S. Bajwa, Advocate, for the complainant has stated that the petitioner is running a travel agency and he has issued the cheque amounting to Rs.10,00,000/-, which was dishonoured and has also assured to pay an amount of Rs.5,00,000/-, which

was due and payable by the petitioner. It has also been brought to the knowledge of the Court by learned State counsel that there are other FIRs pending against the petitioner.

In view of the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case as well as the statement made by the learned State counsel above, I do not deem it just and appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. The present petition, is therefore, dismissed.
