Prayer in the instant petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the petitioner on emergency parole for a period of two months on medical grounds.

In compliance of order dated 08.09.2021, status report by way of short affidavit of Rajiv Kumar Arora, PPS, Additional Superintendent, Central Jail, Faridkot has been filed by leaned State counsel along with the report of the Jail Medical Officer. As per the report filed by the Medical Officer concerned, the petitioner is admittedly HIV positive and is also undergoing treatment for tuberculosis. It has also been stated in the said report that the patient is facing problems with his breathing for which he requires medical management.

In the facts and circumstances and keeping in view the report of the Medical Officer, this Court deems it appropriate to order the release of the petitioner on parole on medical grounds.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on parole for a period of six weeks from the date of release on furnishing of requisite personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the authorities concerned.
