The petitioner has filed the present (second) petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short, "the Cr.P.C.") for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.0014 dated 01.11.2018 registered under Sections 15 and 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station City Balachaur, District SBS Nagar.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that the prosecution evidence has been concluded in the case and even statement of the petitioner under Section 313 of the Cr.P.C. has been recorded and the case is fixed for defence evidence.
