1. Today physical hearing was held but on request of learned counsel for the petitioner, the matter is taken up by way of hybrid hearing.
2. This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 199, dated 6th October, 2020, under Section 22, 25 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Rajasansi, District Amritsar.
3. The only ground pressed for bail is that trial is not progressing.
4. Learned State counsel submits that recovery from the petitioner is commercial quantity. He submits that there was delay in the progress of the trial due to COVID-19 situation and an earnest effort would be made to conclude the prosecution evidence without undue delay.
5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.
