Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to count the services rendered by the petitioner on *ad hoc* basis towards seniority for promotion.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from his client, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case, representation dated 02.01.2021 (P-5) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 02.01.2021 (P-5), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four months from today.
