Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that his client, who was on the bail in the present case, could not appear in the Trial Court in the year 2010 and beginning of 2011 as he was already in custody in connection with some other cases.

2. Attention of the Court is drawn to copy of the judgment passed by the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Sonapat in connection with the sessions case arising out of FIR No.41 dated 18.03.2010, under Sections 302, 364, 436, 404, 120-B, 201 & 34 of the IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Gohana, on perusal of which, it is seen that the petitioner was actually in custody at the relevant time.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Anmol Malik, DAG, Haryana to accept notice on behalf of the respondent/State. Let a copy of the Paperbook be supplied to him.

5. In view of the circumstances narrated above, the present petition is disposed off with a liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within 10 days from today, in which case, he may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the said Court during this period operation of the impugned order passed against him shall remain stayed.

6. This order shall automatically stand vacated after 17.09.2021.
