Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.177 dated 29.07.2021, under Sections 323, 452, 354 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshairpur.

By virtue of the order dated 01.09.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
