The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeks quashing of the transfer order dated 17.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) from Government College for Women, Murthal to Government College for Women, Gohana, which is stated to be in violation of the Policy and Guidelines dated 07.04.1989 (Annexure P-3).

Counsel has submitted that he was transferred to Murthal on 20.10.2020 (Annexure P-1) and now vide order dated 17.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) is being sent back to Gohana.

A perusal of the above orders would go on to show that on an earlier occasion it was a temporary transfer and it was vice Ms. Sarita Lakra. Even the present order is also vice Ms. Sarita Lakra, who has not been impleaded as party.

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Keeping in view the above, this Court does not feel as such to interfere in the transfer order, in the absence of any allegations of malafides. It is settled principle that before approaching this Court, the employees should represent before the appropriate authority for redressal of their grievances.

Faced with this situation, counsel does not press the present writ petition and prays for liberty to file appropriate representation.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
