Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for quashing the action of the respondents in not considering and granting the petitioner her due promotion under Master/Mistress Cadre as per 1% promotion quota provided under the Punjab Educational (Teaching Cadre) Group 'C' (First Amendment) Rules, 2020. Further prayer is for quashing the impugned order dated 21.07.2021 (P-15).

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representation dated 01.07.2021 (P-13) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Director of Public Instructions (S.E.), Punjab to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 01.07.2021 (P-13) in accordance with law by passing speaking order preferably within a period of 02 (two) months from today and if need be, petitioner be also associated before taking final decision in the matter, subject to due protocol.
