The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.43 dated 13.04.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 332, 353, 323, 379 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Sections 27 and 29 of the Wild Life Protection Act, 1972 and Sections 32 and 33 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 in Police Station Partapnagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 01.12.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are that he was found in possession of 06 pieces of *khair* wood and a wood cutter.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Gurmej Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact but opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that the petitioner was involved in similar cases in

the year 2005, however, there is no complaint against him from the year 2005 till registration of the present FIR.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 01.12.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
